Western Trail Ride lesson (For all ages:) \$50 person

Western trail ride - Enjoy spectacular field views and wooded trails that combine learning with every trail ride; includes grooming interaction and tack up which is an exciting family event followed by a serene peaceful riding experience.

Mommy/Daddy and Me:

Enjoy quality time while learning and riding together. Light instructional lessons include walk, lead line trot, and ground pole sessions with horses, Mommies/Daddies, and children. Meet friends while interacting with horses.

Beginner youth:

Introduction to walk, posting trot, halt and backup instruction sessions on and off lunge line with emphasis on turning and maintaining balance seat and riding consistency; sessions also include grooming, hooves, and barn chore activity.

Double Digit Intermediate:

Gain new learning experience with existing and continuing trot advancement, and canter work, while honing existing skills; includes ground and raised trot poles, plus beginner jumping. Barn activities include bathing, blanketing, bits, and grooming for success.

Show Class Advanced:

Incorporating existing riding skills with learning new techniques and experience horse knowledge to new show class heights, includes advanced lessons, jumps, dressage techniques and show class grooming and competition.

Spending Time with Horses: Adult/Youth Program long course *

Horses can be relaxing, therapeutic, a good form of physical exercise, motivating, a confidence builder, a means to follow a passion, or for just plain enjoyment. Class activities to include basic barn skills and daily horse care, safety around horses, handling horses between the stall and cross ties, knowledge of tools, cleaning and grooming skills, understanding stall upkeep, aspects of feeding, knowledge of tack and riding equipment safety. A program centered on the daily horses activities and the class includes introductory indoor arena Group riding lesson. The activities will take place in a state of the art barn, fully equipped with lights, heated rooms, full size bathroom, indoor arena, wide isles, and cross ties for the instructional class to take place.
